Mannington Hall was originally built around 1460 for William Lumnor who was connected to the Paston family and then sold to Horatio, the first Lord Walpole in the middle of the 18th century. Horatio was the diplomat brother of Sir Robert Walpole, known as our first Prime Minister. The medieval hall is surrounded by a moat and set in stunning natural and formal gardens. The renowned Heritage Rose Garden was created largely by the current Lord Walpole and boasts over 1000 varieties. Lord and Lady Walpole invite you to enjoy your special celebration within their magical grounds.
